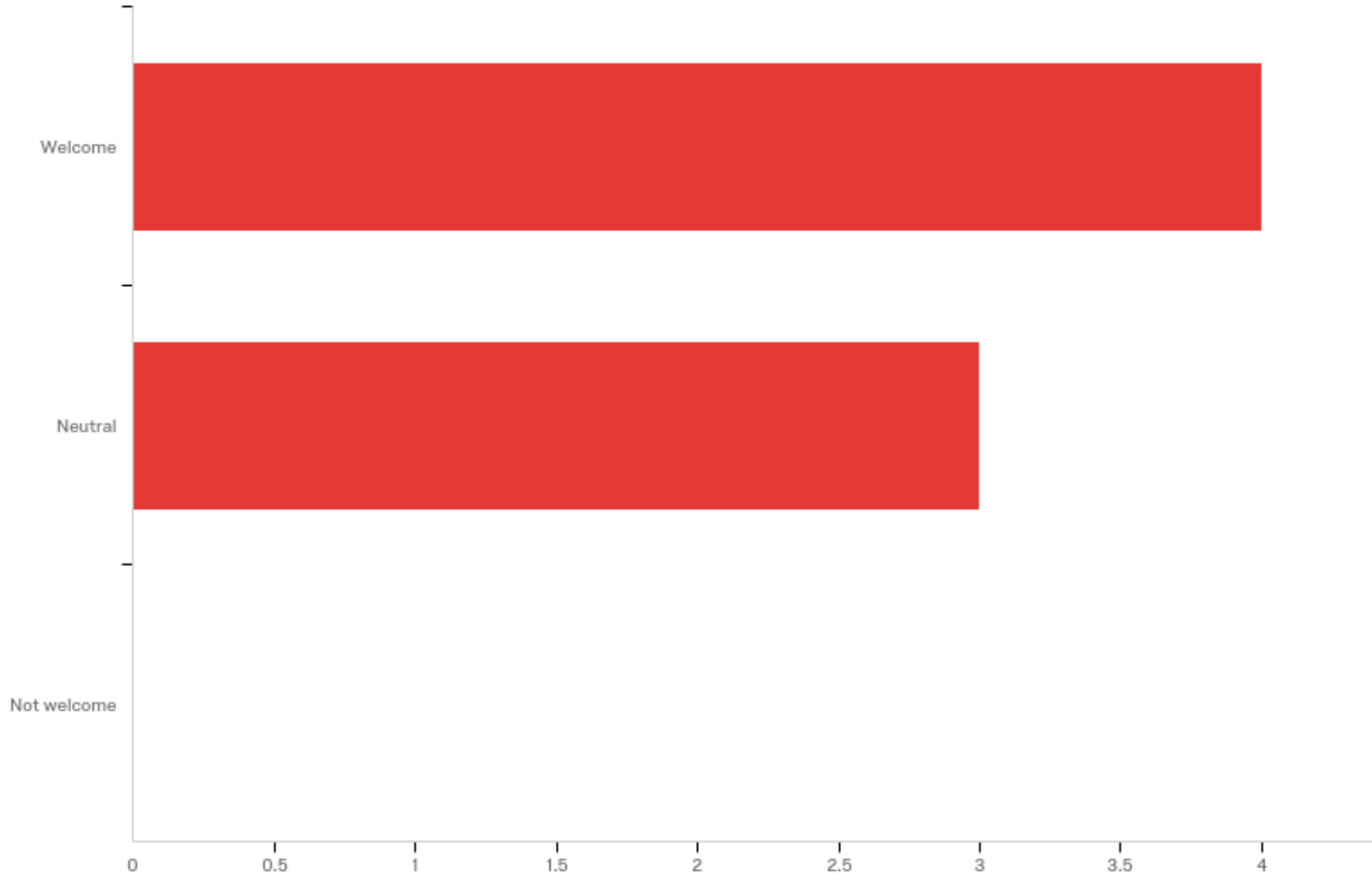
Vere informative, hands on course. I truly appreciate the more interactive flow of the course which provides very enriching networking.

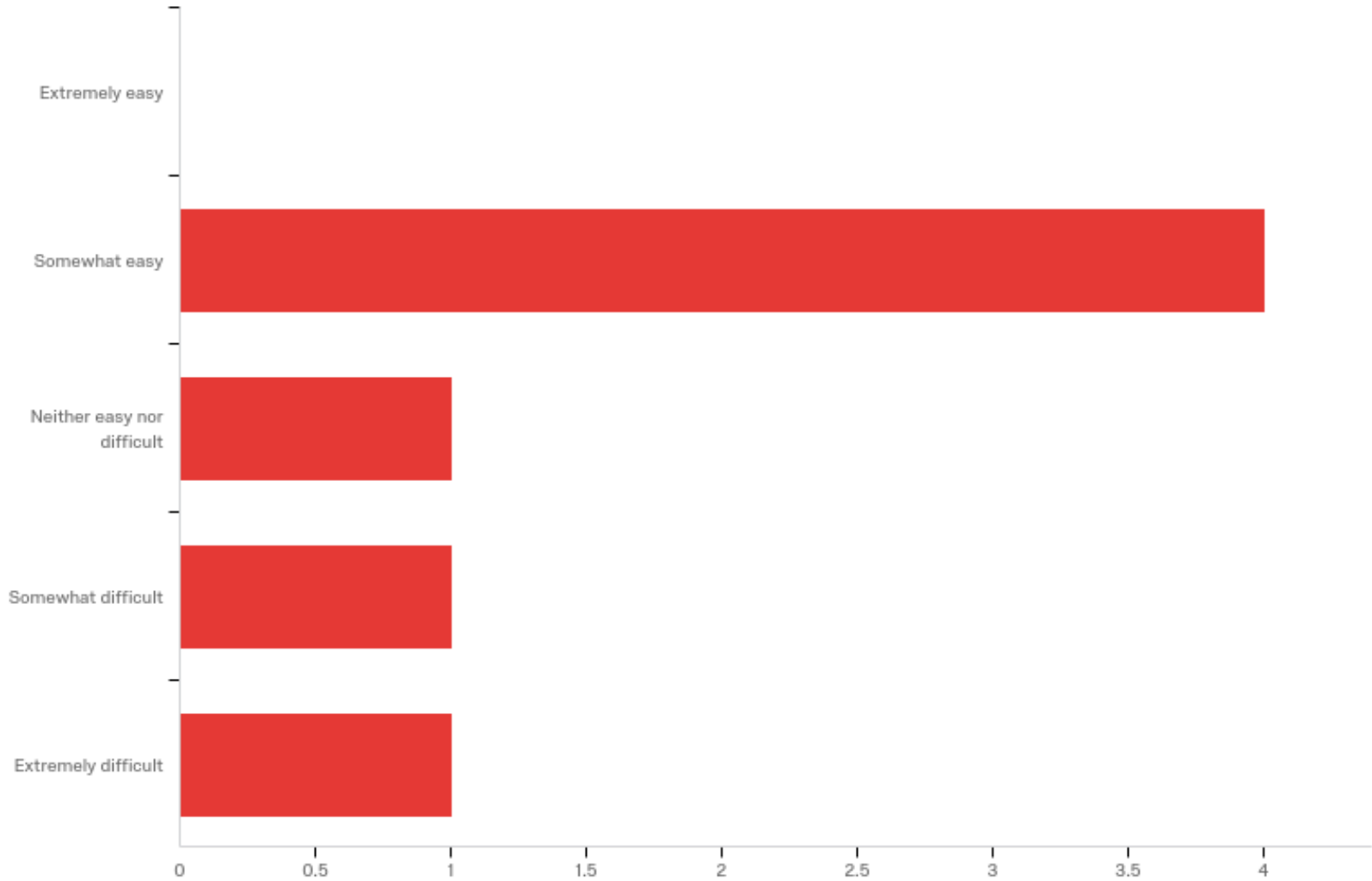
It would be great to have even more contact with other participants

I have trouble paying attention during some of the video lectures where I can't see the speaker's face (just hear the voice; what is more effective for me is engaging with specific readings (summarizing/annotating) or doing specific activities

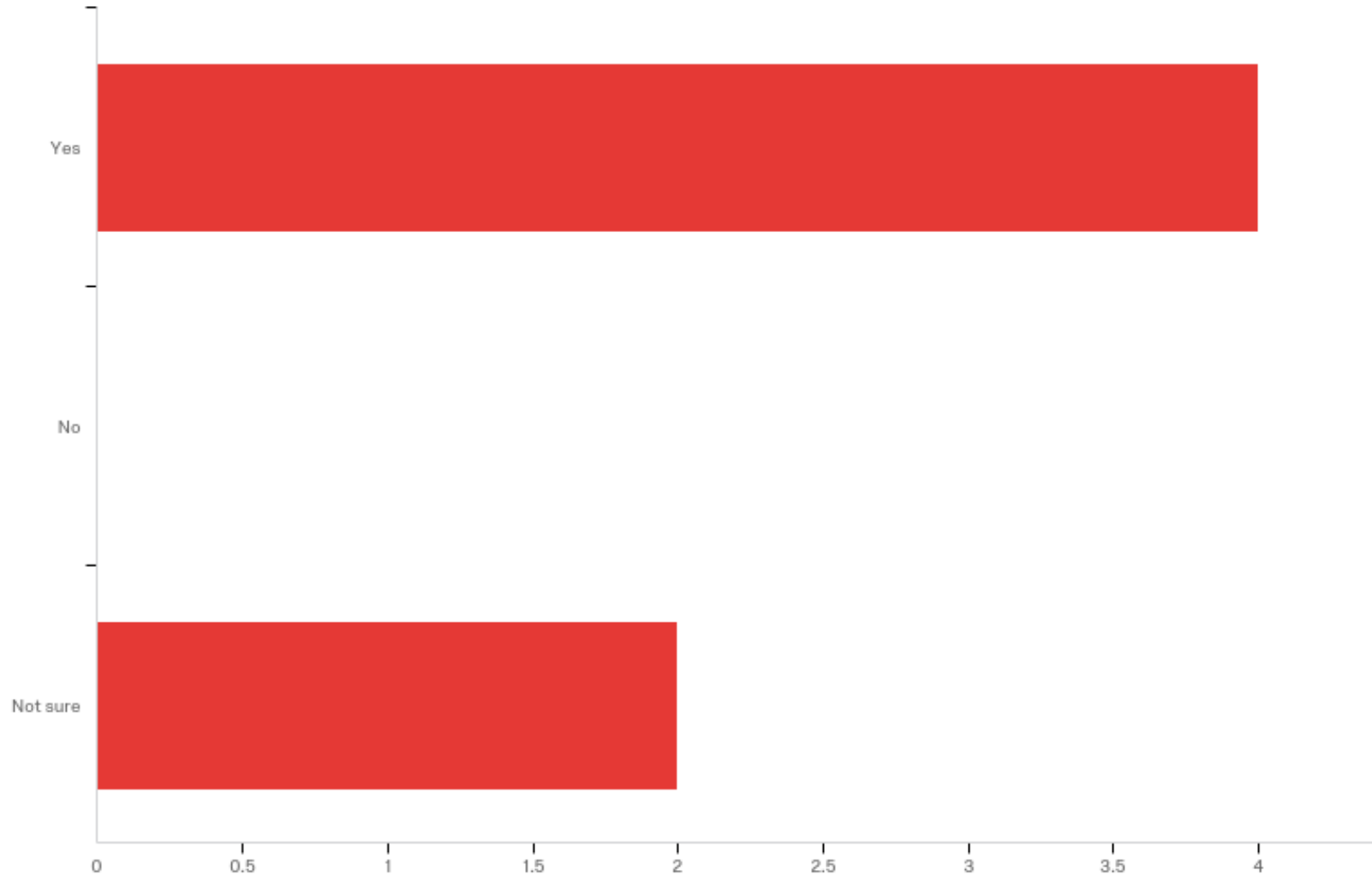

Q11 - Were you able to express dissatisfaction with the environment, activities or instructor facilitation?



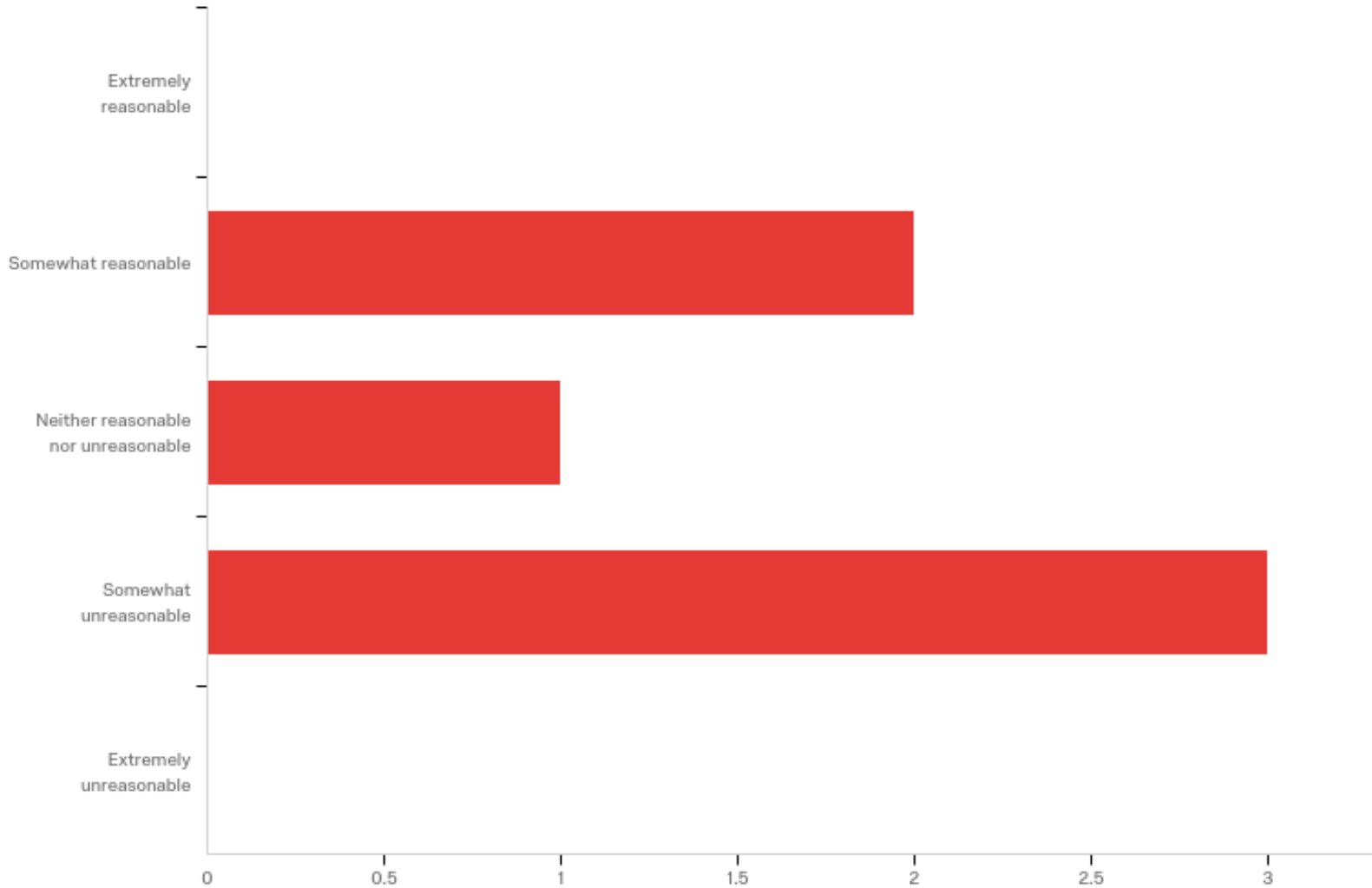

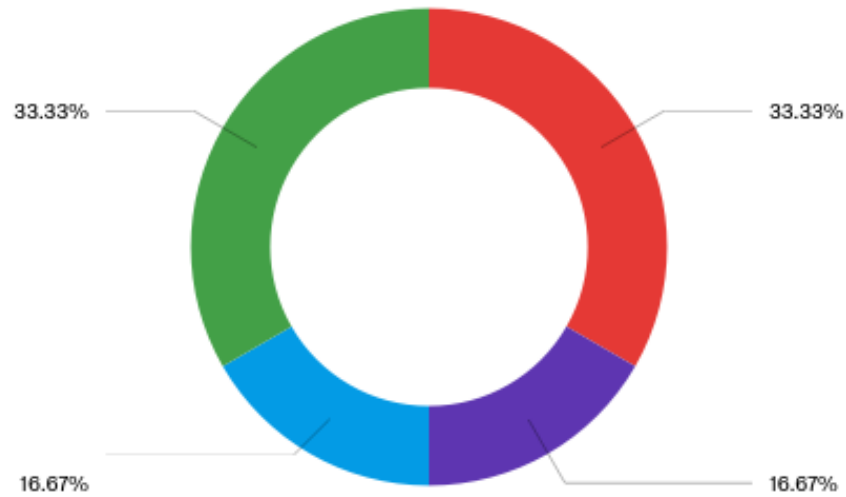

Overall, I am really enjoying this course. I do think that it might be a bit too ambitious for the amount of time many instructors have.

Workload is always very subjective, but finding 6 hours in a week, particularly when deadlines are scatter across a week so that I have to get certain things done in a day or two, is very challenging. It may well be different for others, but for me, its easiest to find time to work on this in a block on the weekend, and I am unlikely to get much done in a given week before then. Also, I don't find I need a lot of interactivity. Having readings and time to think about them is probably most helpful

After reading the article in 4.3, I am confident that we have great guidance to become excellent online facilitators and make pedagogical decisions that will help us prove online courses of high quality.
